Since its founding, APC has enrolled more than 14,000 children and has provided care through more than 214,000 clinical visits.



APC has been recognized as a highest level Patient-Centered Medical Home by the National Committee on Quality Assurance (NCQA).

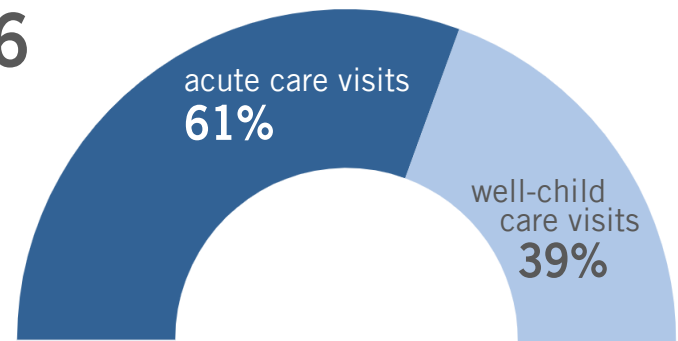

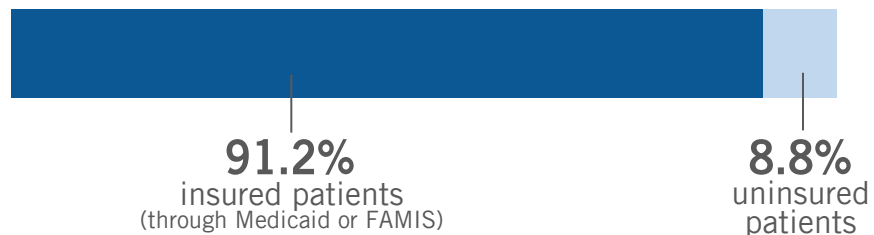
