Expenses Related to COVID-19 Mitigation**

Area of Need	Examples
Consumables & Incremental Material Costs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • N95 masks (the Hospital uses more than 400 per day) • Other PPE, such as face/eye shields, gloves, isolation gowns (approx. 3,000 per day), head & shoe covers • Testing kits • Cleaning and sanitizing supplies • Premium prices due to supply shortages
Equipment & Staffing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ventilators (the Hospital needs at least 100) as well as nebulizer treatment equipment • Configuring additional treatment areas on the main campus (converting inpatient units, and/or specially equipped tents, etc.) as well as cross-training staff • Testing equipment, such as the new Abbot Lab Point of Care testing platform • Additional security staff to monitor access points
Facility Improvement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Retrofitting ICU rooms for negative-pressure capability • Special wayfinding and information signage, as well as security systems, to support restricted access to the campus
Medical Practice Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Financial support, such as rent relief, to independent medical practices located at the Hospital, all of which are seeing dramatic declines in patient volume
