
The COVID-19 pandemic, however, has led to a "new normal" for everyone in the healthcare space. Virginia Hospital Center is no exception. We are seeing a daily increase in the number of admitted patients with confirmed and suspected COVID-19, and we have many patients with COVID-19 in our ICU and on ventilators. This new normal comes with a price tag. **Consider the following investments the Hospital must make over the next three to six months:**

Area of Need	Examples	Projected Cost
Material Costs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> N95 masks (the Hospital uses 350 per day) Other PPE, such as face and eye shields, gloves, gowns, head and shoe covers Testing kits and cleaning and sanitizing supplies 	\$1 million
Equipment and Staffing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Additional ventilators as well as nebulizer treatment and testing equipment Additional security staff to monitor access points 	\$500,000
Facility Improvement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Retrofitting ICU rooms for negative-pressure capability Security systems, to support restricted access to the campus 	\$1 million
Medical Practice Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Financial support, such as rent relief, to independent medical practices located at the Hospital, all of which are seeing dramatic declines in patient volume 	\$500,000
Estimated total:		\$3,000,000
