COST OF N95 MASKS

In an average year, Virginia Hospital Center spends \$.95 per N95 mask. Currently the cost per mask is \$5.00, increasing five-fold during the COVID-19 pandemic.



NEW NEGATIVE PRESSURE ICU ROOMS

The Hospital is reconfiguring all of its Intensive Care rooms to be negative pressure rooms. This \$100,000+ renovation, happening because of COVID-19, will ensure that contaminated air cannot escape that room. This is a permanent change to these rooms and will be a community benefits for years to come.



TESTS PER DAY AT COLLECTION SITE

Thanks to Virginia Hospital Center's partnership with Arlington County and Mayo Clinic, we are able to steadily increase available sampling for symptomatic adults with an appointment. For more information visit www.vhcupdates.com.

Virginia Hospital Center is stocked with three months' worth of personal protective equipment (PPE) and is monitoring that supply closely. If we experience a surge, our current supply with our rationing system, will last 4-6 weeks. We are grateful to all community members who have offered donations of PPE.
